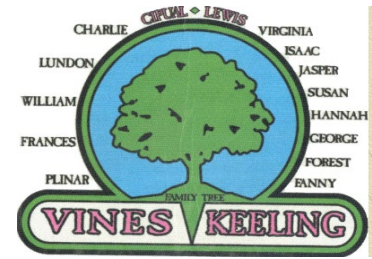

Why is Education Important?

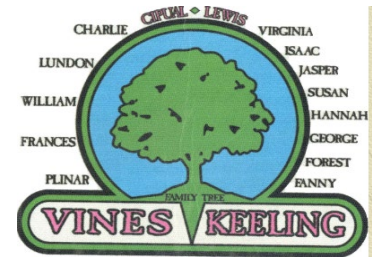

There are more children enrolling in school and Teacher retirements are rising which opens more jobs. This is a sample of occupations with future job prospects and average starting pay in parenthesis (...):

- 1) K-12 Teacher (Good - \$49,530/year);
- 2) Teacher's Aide (Excellent - \$27,000/year);
- 3) Teaching Assistant (Good to Excellent - \$30,000/year);
- 4) Childcare Development Specialist (Excellent - \$32.490/year);
- 5) Pre-K Teacher (Excellent - \$43,670/year).

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How to Prepare for a Career in Education?

If you are interested in a career in Education, there are a few different ways you can get started. One option is to excel in Core education courses (Reading/Math & Science) in high school or community college. Also, hone your written and verbal skills. Volunteer and/or Intern in educational settings.
