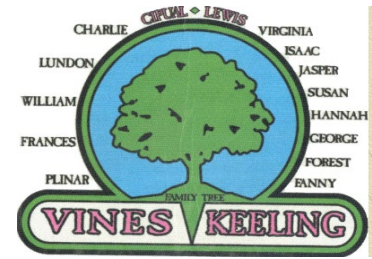

What are the Benefits of a Career in Education?

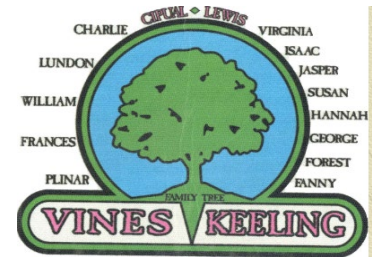
A career in education offers a unique and rewarding set of benefits. Such as:

Occupations for High School graduates:

- 1) Education Assistant – (\$32,500/year) w/HS Diploma + Certificates;
- 2) Substitute Teacher – (\$125/day) w/College Degree;
- 3) Early Childhood Teacher Assistant – (\$27,500/year) w/HS Diploma + Certificates;
- 4) Library Assistant – (\$32,500/year) w/HS Diploma + Certificates;
- 5) Tutor – (\$35/hour) w/HS Diploma + Certificates.

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How to Prepare for a Career in Education?

If you are interested in a career in the Education Industry, there are a few different ways you can get started. Do well in Core education courses (Reading/Math & Science) in high school or community college. Also, hone your written and verbal skills. Volunteer and shadow a Teacher.
